I worked in retail most of life at Buchheits in Herculaneum where I was the Department Manager of Farm, Farm Equipment, Large Animals, feed and seed, and small animals and love it. I also drove a school bus for many years, and I am licensed though the state of Missouri to train others. I played league softball till 25 yrs. old, and I love to fish. I make candles, do crafts, make wicker baskets and sew. If there's something I'd like to do, I'll try it. After we sold the farm and I retired, we moved to Herculaneum MO and I took care of grandbabies. After my husband retired, we moved permanently to Table Rock Lake.

I've never painted in my life, just craft paint. I took shop in school because I like tools and with farm work it was a better choice for me. My neighborhood friend Stan introduced me to Marjorie Peterson in 2017 and that was the first time I ever had a canvas in front of me. She has guided me to where I'm at today. She calls me her detailed artist. She is my inspiration, my guide, my friend. I can call her or go to her and she's always there for me with guidance and patience, God love her.

I work with Acrylics. I tried Oils but had a severe asthma attack so that's out. I started painting on canvas in 2017.

I have my own room for the first time to do all the things I love to do, it's my Happy, Happy Place and whatever I'm doing, Murder She Wrote does it with me 😊.

I like Landscapes mountains, water, and snow.

I can get lost in landscapes. To me it's just peaceful and meaningful - a place to think and rest.

I don't really have a favorite artist of a different time period I'm too new at this. But I do enjoy the Master and Mentors we do each year through the Guild, it gives me a chance to research some of the old artist of the 1800's to early 1900's.

I enjoy painting - I paint most nights after my husband and pup (Mr. Rizzoli) go to bed. It relaxes

me and helps me wind down as my brain is always turning things over. It's nothing for me to be up past 1:00 a.m. I'm a night owl, always have been and at this age that's not going to change. I feel extremely blessed. I've always had a supportive husband and family in whatever I tried.



COLOR MAGIC

Dear Friends of the Table Rock Art Guild,

We are excited about our upcoming 40th Annual Fall Festival of the Arts, "Color Magic", presented on Saturday and Sunday, October 2 & 3, at the Kimberling Area Library. We invite you to become a Patron, which entitles you to an exclusive pre-show evening of wine and hors d'oeuvres Friday, Oct. 1 from 5 to 8 p.m.

As a Patron, your name will be placed on the Patrons Board, prominently displayed at the show and also will be listed in every attendee's Exhibitor's Guide. On Friday night, you can meet with the artists and purchase artwork before the show opens to the public. We ask only for a donation to help support the Arts in our community. The good news is that 80 percent of your donation is yours to spend at the show on the artwork of your choice. For example, a \$25 donation will provide you with a credit certificate of \$20; a \$50 donation provides a \$40 certificate; \$100 = \$80; \$250 = \$200 and \$500 = \$400. For your convenience, your certificate will be available for pickup at the pre-show. If you cannot attend on Friday night, your certificate will still be available and may be used on the following Saturday or Sunday.

The tickets for our Annual Art Drawing will be available for purchase at the show — \$1 each or \$5 for six tickets. Each of our previous Top 5-selling artists donated the art for the drawing, which will take place on Sunday at 3:45 p.m. You need not be present to win and you can indicate your preference of art on the reverse side of the ticket. If that art is still available when your ticket is drawn, it will be saved for you. You may preview the art at our Gallery in the Courtyard of Kimberling City Center any time after Sept. 4th or on our website: www.tablerockartgallery.com.

Please complete and return the enclosed information with a check for your donation made payable to Table Rock Art Guild. If you would like further notification, please provide us with your email address. We will send a reminder about the show as it draws near.

We look forward to seeing you at this year's "Color Magic", Art Festival.


