KY3 Video: Sneak peek of the TRAG Interview with Kadee from KY3. To be aired on Thursday, January 22, at 3:30pm on The Place.

Artist Challenge: January's artist challenge is Shadows. Next month the artist challenge will be Color Study.

Program: Diane Robben introduced the plein-air guest speaker Farley Lewis, "Creating Bold & Fearless Art". Farley led a very inspiring discussion on painting with bold and fearless art. He explained the four elements of boldness: Carefree with childlike wonder and excitement, Courage by taking more risks, Confidence with ample practice, and Clarity by having a clear goal or standard of excellence. Farley encouraged artists by explaining that "Boldness in Art" is ten percent Technique and ninety percent Mindset.

Meeting to Order: President Jennifer Cole requested approval for the December Membership Minutes, which were printed in the January Newsletter. Motioned by Brenda Viveiros and 2nd by Linda Edge-Dunlap. All in favor.

Treasurer's Report: Posted on bulletin board in gallery office. Kim Briggs discussed the requirement for W-9's to be filled out by artists displaying in the gallery. This form is to be filled out and filed in the gallery in order for artists to get paid for artwork sold in the gallery.

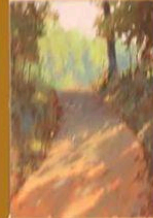

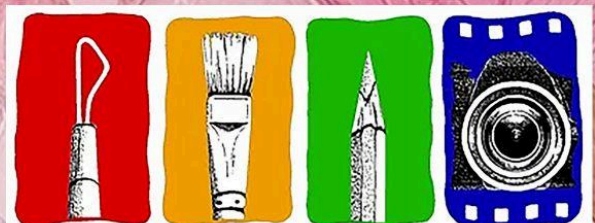
